



Bosworlas Boulders OS explorer 102 GR 3037

The boulder lies off the B3306 St Just to Lands End. From St Just take the small road that lies between Kelynack and Bosavern, the road follows the bottom of the valley after a few minutes its possible to see the boulders on the hill to the left park and take the footpath over a field and approach to the left of the boulders. Don't be dismayed they are better on the other side!

There are a handful of decent problems and scope for some more. The rock isn't that great, a bit crumbly and lots of lichen and moss. However the sopt has appeal and the problems are good, some classic and one or two quite unusual.

The boulders have been climbed on for some years, the easier problems haveing been done by lands End CC officers. Recently John Burgess, Barnaby Carver and Andy Whall have been known to climb there with BC and AW responsible for Peroxide Wall and Peroxide Wall Traverse respectively.

1. V6 *Tuna*
2. V2 Climb the wall to the left of the boulder and to the right of the left edge.
3. V5 *Princess*
4. V6 *Peroxide Wall*. from the horizontal finger slots climb past a useless sloper to better holds.
5. V6 *Peroxide Wall Traverse*, from the rounded arete use a collection of slopers and crimps to reach the finish of peroxide Wall.
6. V2 Blunt arete from sit start, finish with right hand in large dish.
7. V0 Takes the easiest line from sit start into the dish
8. V6 Traverse R-L from problem 7-2 using the low break.
